ORDINANCE NO. 3841

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A STOP SIGN ON MORTON AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH MCKINLEY AVENUE BY AMENDING SCHEDULE I STOP INTERSECTIONS OF CHAPTER 77 TRAFFIC SCHEDULES, OF TITLE 7 TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY CODE, AND DECLARING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS,

After receiving a request from an area resident and observing of typical traffic patterns at the intersection of Morton Avenue and McKinley Street, Kewanee's City Engineer and Kewanee's Chief of Police has made a recommendation to establish a stop sign at the intersection of Morton Avenue and McKinley Avenue due to the limited visibility of the intersection; and,

WHEREAS,

Mayor and City Council hereby accept the recommendation, and find it to be in the best interest of motorist and pedestrian safety to establish an intersection regulated by a STOP sign on Morton Avenue at its intersection with McKinley Avenue

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEWANEE, ILLINOIS, IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED, AS FOLLOWS.

SECTION ONE:

Schedule I "Stop Intersections" of Chapter 77 Traffic Schedules of the City Code shall be, and hereby is, amended by inserting the underlined words (sample) shown below in the appropriate alphabetized location:

Intersection	Corner
Mckinley Avenue and Morton Avenue on Morton Avenue	SouthEast

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
