

RESOLUTION NO. 5032

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HIRE PARAMEDIC TRAINING PROFESSIONALS ON A CONTRACT BASIS TO PROVIDE PARAMEDIC TRAINING TO CITY EMPLOYEES, AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE IMMEDIATELY.

- WHEREAS, The City of Kewanee has a need for trained paramedics; and,
WHEREAS, The Kewanee City Council finds it in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to contract with educators to provide paramedic training; and
WHEREAS, Cottage Hospital, the facility that serves as the City of Kewanee's EMS Resource Hospital, has identified qualified personnel to serve as instructors for the training; and,
WHEREAS, The City will contract with approximately five (5) Paramedic Trainers at \$18 per hour, for approximately 700 total hours, resulting in a total cost of approximately \$12,600.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEWANEE THAT:

- Section 1** The City Manager is authorized to execute the necessary documents to hire Paramedic Training professionals on a contract basis to provide paramedic training to City employees as outlined above.
- Section 2** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
